1. General

2. Scope

This privacy policy applies to the online presence of Mahara Mc Kay at the domain "<https://www.maharamckay.info>" and to the personal data collected through these websites. 3. What happens to your data?

3.1 Types of personal data processed by us

Personal data are data that can be used to identify you or otherwise attributed to you. We process certain personal data that you and third parties voluntarily provide to us, e.g., when you contact us via email or other means of communication. The personal data we process may include name, first name, email address, telephone numbers, year of birth, and home addresses.

3.2 How we use your personal data

3.3 Why and on what legal basis do we process your personal data?

3.4 Where and how do we store your personal data?

The Mahara Mc Kay company is a Swiss company, and all your personal data provided on our website are processed and stored exclusively on servers of the Mahara Mc Kay company. In connection with booked services on our service platform WIX, additional personal data may be collected and stored. 3.5 Where we send your data

Visitor comments may be checked by an automated spam detection service. For users who register on our website, we also store the personal information they provide in their user profiles. Website administrators can also view and modify this information. In connection with booked services on our service platform <https://www.maharamckay.info>, additional personal data may be collected and stored. 3.6 How long do we store your personal data?

The personal data we collect is only stored for as long as necessary to fulfill the respective purpose. Legal requirements or other obligations may result in longer retention periods.

3.7 Your rights

Please note, however, that we reserve the right to assert the legally provided restrictions ourselves, for example, if we are obligated to retain or process certain data, have a predominant interest (to the extent we may rely on it), have an active business relationship, or need it to assert claims.
